# THE MAIN DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SOFT AND HARD SKILLS

- **Hard skills** are **specific technical knowledge and trainings**.

- Examples: Graphic Design, Data Analysis or Project Management.

- **Soft skills** are **people skills** which are learned and developed over time from dealing with difficult situations.


